There will be two scholarships awarded in the amount of \$2500.00. Decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final. Recipients must provide proof of registration as full-time students attending an accredited post-secondary institution in the fall of 2024.

All applications must be accompanied by a passport size photo. Scholarships will be awarded by the end of December 2024.
